

GREEN MOUNTAIN POWER CORPORATION

RESIDENTIAL RATE 01

AVAILABILITY:

Except as noted below, service under this rate is available to residential Customers for single-phase electric service in individual private dwellings or individual apartments, including electric house heating and water heating, and, on an optional basis, to farms engaged principally in the raising of crops, horticulture, forestry, husbandry, stock raising, dairying, or poultry raising and egg production. This rate is not available to Customers other than farms to serve nonresidential purposes with a combined connected load in excess of 5 kW.

Special contract rates may be required for Customers whose unique requirements impose significant costs upon the Company that are not recovered through application of the Company's standard tariffs. These contract rates will be subject to approval of the Vermont Public Service Board.

Availability of this rate is limited to Customers whose average consumption during any four consecutive months is less than 7600 kWh per month. Customers whose average monthly consumption meet or exceed this level will become ineligible for this rate and will be transferred to Residential Time-of-Use Rate 61.

DURATION OF CONTRACT:

Subject to termination at any time upon notice, unless a longer term applies as provided in Terms and Conditions.

RATE:

Monthly Customer Charge of \$10.57 plus  
All energy at \$0.13841 per kWh.

### ALTERNATIVE REGULATION PLAN

This tariff is subject to the Company's Alternative Regulation Plan Rider ("ARP Rider"), which includes a quarterly Power Adjustor and an annual Earnings Sharing Adjustor. These adjustors appear as separate line items on the customer's monthly bill. For a complete description of these adjustors, see the ARP Rider.

### MINIMUM CHARGE:

The Customer Charge of \$10.57 per month or a fraction thereof, unless a higher minimum applies, as provided in Terms and Conditions.

### SUSPENSION OF SERVICE:

Where service has been suspended at customer's request the minimum charge shall not be applicable during such suspension, but, in lieu thereof, an initial service fee of \$35.00 plus a reconnect fee of \$35.00 during working hours or \$150.00 during other than normal working hours shall be made when service is re-established at the request of the customer.

Move Ins-Move-Outs: The Company shall provide a credit of \$35.00 to any customer whose Move In or Move Out order is not completed within three business days of the date promised to the customer on the Service Order. See Terms and Conditions tariff for additional credit instructions.

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

The above rate is net, billed monthly or bi-monthly at the option of the Company and payable on presentation of the bill.

The Company's other Terms and Conditions in effect from time to time, where not inconsistent with any specific provisions hereof, are a part of this rate.

For Customers who were receiving service under the Company's dual-fuel/storage heat program requiring two or more meters and who were converted to this rate on October 1, 2002,

the Company may continue to meter the Customer's total service with two or more meters and the consumption at all meters will be added together for billing purposes and be billed to the Customer as one account.
